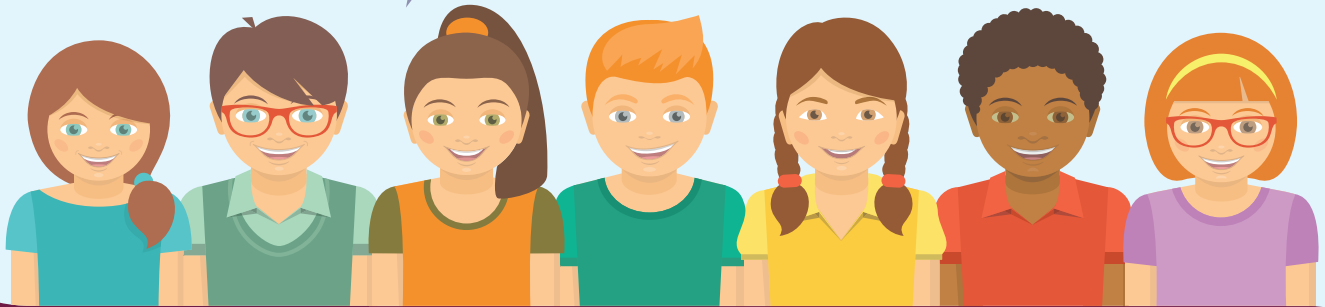




# SUPPORTING MULTILINGUAL CLASSROOMS WORKSHOP
